### The Prince's Trust

The Prince's Trust supports young people (13 to 30 years old) who are unemployed and those struggling at school and at risk of exclusion.

Trust programmes give young people the practical and financial support they need to stabilize their lives by developing key skills and building confidence and motivation.

### Developing Practical Skills for Local Oxford Youth

The aim of the project was to support young people not in employment, education or training aged between 16-25 years, to develop their skills, gain experience and provide a route either directly into employment in the NHS or onto pathways into employment in the sector.

In collaboration with the Oxford University Hospitals NHS Trust (OUH) and The Prince's Trust, Carillion helped to deliver a workshop for 5 individuals who were on placement in the Portering and Catering teams during May and June 2014. We wanted to recruit suitably motivated participants, oversee the delivery of training and provide on-going progression support. The 4 week programme was driven by our Portering and Catering supervisors who trained the placements and supported them. Our Operational Managers and Senior Management Team also helped to deliver the Induction programme and carried out a Carillion Values workshop which the individuals thoroughly enjoyed!

Both our partners - OUH Trust and The Prince's Trust, later sent their thanks to the team for the support and help that was provided.
