Project Brief

The aim of the EnergySave Programme (20,000 households across 22 boroughs) was to reduce residents' fuel bills, improve energy efficiency and mitigate against fuel poverty.

EEVS' role was to evaluate the programme, working with the Tavistock Institute. EEVS analysed data, captured as part of the programme, to determine the energy savings achieved by residents and the programme's overall impact.
